## Bradbury/Duarte Earth Day Event

## Street Parking Restrictions

The City would like to remind its community members of the parking restrictions in place. Please note there is restricted parking in the following listed areas:

- Bradbury Hills Lane, both sides, for the entire length thereof
- Bradbury Hills Road, both sides, for the entire length thereof
- Bradbury Road, east side only, for the entire length thereof
- Lemon Ave, north side only for the entire length thereof
- Mt. Olive Dr. northerly of Woodlyn Lane to the City limits
- Royal Oaks Drive North, both sides, for the entire length thereof
- Winston Avenue both sides, for the entire length thereof
- Woodlyn Lane, within gated area, both sides, for the entire length thereof
- Woodlyn Lane, outside the gated area, both sides, for the entire length thereof

Residents and/or guests may risk a parking citation if they are found parking in any of the areas mentioned above.

## Monrovia Partnership with Lyft

Last month, the City of Monrovia launched a new transportation alternative also available to Bradbury residents. This new program offers \$0.50 rides with the car sharing provider, Lyft. Below are a few tips to help you begin taking advantage of the fixed fare rides with Lyft:



- Download the app from your smart phone's app store.
- Sign up to create an account.
- Open the app and click on your profile in the top right-hand corner of the homepage. Select "Promos" and enter promo code **GOMONROVIA** before requesting a ride. Once the code is entered and applied to your account, you will not have to enter it again!
- On the app's homepage, set your pickup location and add your destination address. Make sure you have "Lyft—4 seats" selected from the list of vehicle options available before requesting Lyft.
- Make sure your pick-up and drop-off locations are within the Monrovia service area (City of Monrovia, Bradbury, unincorporated parts of Los Angeles County adjacent to Monrovia, and Target in Duarte. Passengers may also be taken to medical appointments at physician offices within three miles of City limits, as well as City of Hope).
- Once the driver arrives, be sure to double-check that you are boarding the correct vehicle by verifying the vehicle's license plate number and asking the driver's name.
- You may notice that on the app, the end date listed on the code is April 8, 2018. Do not worry! The code will automatically renew itself every month.

While this new alternative is available, **Dial-A-Ride services will continue to accommodate riders with ADA-related and wheelchair needs, but the fare to ride now costs \$0.50 for all riders.** Please call (626) 358-3538 to make a reservation for same day service or trips up to one week in advance.

# Updated Construction Hours



In an effort to preserve the rural tranquility in our unique community, Council amended the City's noise ordinance during the December meeting to prohibit construction on the following observed holidays: New Year's Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Thanksgiving Day and Christmas Day. Construction and demolition hours have not been affected and continue to be limited between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on weekdays and the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. on weekends, excluding holidays.
